Conditions:

1. Only parking lots within the Municipal Limits of the City of Aiken, which are open to use by the public for motor vehicle traffic, may be petitioned for police jurisdiction on this form.
2. If approved, the parking lot will be posted, by the City, with signs to inform the public that the area is subject to the police jurisdiction of the City of Aiken.
3. If approved, the petitioner shall pay the city for the number of signs determined by the director of public safety, at a rate specified by City of Aiken Ordinance.
4. Upon posting of the aforementioned signs, the entire area of the parking lot in question shall come under the police jurisdiction of the City of Aiken. The Department of Public Safety shall thereupon have the authority to enforce, in such parking lot, all laws and ordinances relating to the unlawful operation of motor vehicles as applicable to the public streets and highways, as well as all other ordinances of the City of Aiken and laws and statues of the State of South Carolina, including, but not limited to:
  - Aiken City Code Section 6-3, "Drinking alcoholic liquors in specified places prohibited,"
  - Aiken City Code Section 6-4, "Drinking of beer or wine in public places,"
  - Aiken City Code Section 22-12, "Urinating or defecating in public,"
  - Aiken City Code Section 22-31, "Loud, disturbing or unnecessary noise generally,"
  - Aiken City Code Section 22-36, "Noise from vehicles generally,"
  - Aiken City Code Section 22-59, "Possession of drug paraphernalia,"
  - South Carolina Code of Laws 16-11-700, "Dumping litter on private or public property."
